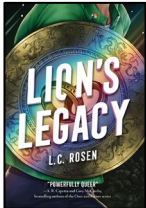


May to August 2023 Dewey Picks – Children’s & Young Adult Titles Canadian Manda Group

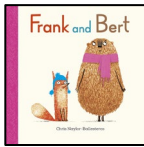
